**JOB TITLE:** Contract Sports Official Roller Hockey Referee **STATUS:** Contract Position  
**HIRE DATE:** ASAP **PAY RATE:** \$26 per match **HOURS:** Varied Nights/Weekends

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Referees are contracted positions and not City employees. Under the guidance of Recreation supervision staff, referees are responsible for effectively officiating Adult inline roller hockey played evenings and weekends at the Torrance Roller Hockey Rink at Wilson Park.

**ESSENTIAL KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE:** To perform this job successfully, a complete understanding of hockey is a must. Explicit and detailed knowledge of the rules is necessary. Referees must detect infractions of rules and decide penalties according to established City of Torrance rules/regulations. Officials are required to pass a written and practical test each year and must maintain satisfactory evaluations to remain under contract.

### ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Know, understand, and be able to enforce through appropriate application of penalties all City of Torrance rules for the program.
- Competent inline-skating ability
- Be in reasonable physical condition that allows for effective completion of responsibilities.
- Maintaining control of play and environment for recreational league, inline roller hockey at all times.
- Approved officiating attire must be worn at all times during scheduled games
- Interaction with players, coaches, and fans is expected to be carried out professionally and with integrity, fairness and honesty.
- Maintain good communication with supervision staff and fellow officials regarding scheduling, rule interpretations, etc. and attend all required meetings and trainings.
- Be on time and prepared for all games scheduled by supervision staff.
- Be able to purchase their own officiating attire and equipment necessary to properly officiate roller hockey.

**CONTRACT SPORTS OFFICIALS:** Sports officials and referees for the City of Torrance Recreation Division Sports Programs ARE CONTRACTED with the City. They ARE NOT employees. Before they are considered eligible, contractors must be at least 18 years of age and will be required to sign a yearly contract subject to evaluation each year as well as Insurance in the appropriate amounts naming the City additionally insured.

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** Contact Recreation Supervisor (Adult Sports) Garrett Craig at [GCraig@TorranceCA.gov](mailto:GCraig@TorranceCA.gov) and you will be emailed an application. Complete and return it ASAP. The most qualified applicants will be asked to an interview. If selected, applicants will be required to obtain and complete specified training that after completion will result in the contractor being placed into the rotation for use as a Roller Hockey Official.
